



Overnight Code of Conduct

The Pensacola Children's Chorus strives to create unique opportunities for singers to grow their musical talent, strengthen their bonds with one another, and experience community outside the rehearsal hall. Some of these experiences include overnight trips and retreats. In order to maintain an environment in which creativity and success can flourish as well as providing a place where each singer can feel a sense of belonging and safety, participating students agree to:

Respect Authority

1. Listen to and follow any and all instruction from a staff member, chaperone, or tour company representative.
2. Show respect and courtesy to any tour company representative, hotel or restaurant employee, and any other community member (they are just as important as any staff member).
3. Refrain from engaging in any illegal activity, including but not limited to the use or possession of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, firearms, all other controlled substances, and/or incendiary devices.

Respect Oneself

1. Maintain a high level of self-control and personal responsibility.
2. Adhere to the stated curfew and lights-out policy to obtain adequate rest and energy needed for rehearsal and performance.
3. Refrain from any endangering behavior that threatens the health, sense of security, and/or safety of any person, including oneself.

Respect Others

1. Treat all singers and adults alike with kindness and respect at all times.
2. Refrain from any harassing behavior, to include any name-calling, bullying, or any other form of discrimination based on gender, race, economic status, sexual orientation, religion, culture, nationality, age, ethnicity, gender orientation, or disability.
3. Refrain from using electronic media to circulate derogatory material of any person, including oneself.
4. Abstain from any use or display of violence.
5. Avoid any behavior that could be interpreted as public affection (i.e. hand-holding, kissing, sitting on laps, etc.).

Respect Property

1. Treat all property, whether personal or someone else's, with utmost respect.
2. Take proper care of all facilities, hotel rooms, transportation vehicles, etc. that are provided for PCC use.
3. Never steal anyone else's belongings.

Respect for Community

1. Actively seek ways to make all PCC singers feel welcomed, involved, and important.
2. Celebrate the concept of teamwork, understanding that our best performance is when we are all working together as a supportive team.
