Spotlight: Grades 1-5

Does your child perform living room concerts? Sing into the nearest hairbrush? Put on fashion shows? Loudly and proudly dance to the beat of their own drum? If so, *Spotlight* is the first step in turning their dreams into reality. Young performers will meet daily to work toward a fully staged performance of **The Journey of the Noble Gnarble**, a dramatic tale of an adventurous young fish who yearns to see the sky. Join the little gnarble on his daring journey, and meet a colorful cast of boisterous blyfish, sneaky subbalubbles, and pernicious plinks along the way! Family members can enjoy a rousing and highly entertaining performance the evening of June 18.

Spotlight is the perfect place for budding young performers to develop their skills in music, movement, and the dramatic arts. Roles for the final performance will be assigned after the first day of camp. As the participants learn their parts, they will delve into the exciting world of theatre, using their creativity to transform into imaginary characters! Participants can expect each day of camp to include lots of singing and dancing, basic acting training, and other fun activities. Each day will begin with a vocal warm-up routine that will allow the participants to explore their singing voices. They will then dive into learning music, dance moves, and staging in preparation for the final performance. Participants can look forward to daily games, a mini field trip on Wednesday, and a fully costumed dress rehearsal on Friday before the curtain rises on **The Journey of the Noble Gnarble**!

Spotlight: Grades 9-12

Incredible local talent and impassioned storytelling come together in *Spotlight*. Performers will present a newly written song cycle called *What We've Become*. Built around participants' abilities and drawn from musicals such as *Dear Evan Hansen*, *Tick Tick Boom*, *Ragtime*, *The Greatest Showman*, and more, audiences will experience an intimate musical reflection on transformation, growth, and perseverance in times of struggle. Performances will be held on June 25 and 26.

Each day of *Spotlight* will begin with a vocal warm-up routine designed to aid young singers in developing healthy habits and techniques. Participants will spend the first few days of camp putting their heads together to create an original musical revue that represents who they are and delivers a powerful message. Once music has been selected, participants can expect each day of camp to include lots of singing (in private, small group, and large group settings), dancing, and other fun activities centered on the performing arts. Wednesdays will feature special activities like games and mini field trips! The final showcase will include fully choreographed group musical numbers, interspersed with solo and small group pieces of the singers' own choosing. We can't wait to shine a spotlight on the brilliant, creative young artists of our community!
